## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Why do you want my child to participate?**

The purpose of this study is to “test the test.” The results of this study will be used to create the final version of the test. Therefore, we need children from all over the United States and of various ages, races/ethnicities, and socioeconomic backgrounds to participate.

### **How old does my child need to be to participate?**

Children between the ages 6-16 are eligible to participate.

### **What will you ask my child to do?**

Each child will be asked to perform different activities, such as answering questions, viewing pictures, and writing symbols. All questions and tasks are age appropriate for your child. Some of the material will be easy for him or her, and some will be more difficult.

### **Will I get the results?**

No. We are not able to give you a score for your child because the test is still being developed. The results from your child’s participation will only be used to make decisions about the final version of the test.

### **Are you going to pay my child?**

Yes. In exchange for your child’s time, he or she will receive a payment in the form of a check. The payment will be mailed to the address provided on the consent form approximately 4-6 weeks after Pearson has received your testing materials.

### **How is Brighton involved with this research?**
